Four Priorities for Action.

Microbiology organizations from around the world have developed 4 priorities for action:



1. Speak With One Global Voice

Form a coalition of microbiology organizations to strengthen credibility, expand political influence, attract partners and amplify the community's voice.



2. Embed Microbial Science in Climate Policy

Engage policymakers, funders, entrepreneurs and advocacy groups to ensure microbial science is reflected in climate strategies and investment decisions.



3. Tell the Story & Share the Science

Use compelling storytelling, advocacy and media strategies to highlight the importance of microbial science in climate discourse.



4. Launch High-Impact Demonstration Projects

Pilot real-world demonstration projects (e.g., enhancing carbon sequestration through wastewater treatment) that showcase the impacts of microbial solutions.
